Sir

I am directed to say that as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, it shall be the duty and responsibility of Management/Principal of the Dental Colleges to create a conductive atmosphere for imparting dental education to the UG/PG Dental students undergoing training in such colleges and take all necessary steps to prevent /prohibit /curb ragging of any type in their Dental Colleges to enable students to study the UG/PG Dental Course and its various parameters and concepts of dental education in a calm and peaceful atmosphere as the dental education requires grueling studies.

Further, the relevant extract of sub-regulation 9.1,8 under the heading Measures for prevention of ragging at the institutions level (before admissions) of the above regulations is reproduce hereunder for your ready reference :-

*9.1.8 At the commencement of the academic session, the Head of the Institution shall convene and address a meeting of various functionaries/agencies, like hostel Wardens, representatives of students, parents/guardians, faculty, district administration including police to discuss the measures to be taken to prevent ragging in the institution and steps to be taken to identify the offenders and punish them suitably."

In view of the above provisions of DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009 and the decision of the General Body of the Dental Council of India arrived in its meeting held on 11th & 12th June 2015 at New Delhi, I am directed to request you to kindly request/call any one member of Dental Council of India from your State or neighboring States (if not available in your State) alongwith various functionaries/agencies, like hostel Wardens, representatives of students, parents/guardiens, faculty, district administration Including police to conduct a Workshop / Seminar / Conference at your Dental College in the month of October, 2019, for periodic training to the members of the Anti Ragging Cells /Committees /Squads of Dental Colleges and for awareness about ragging between all students, and to discuss the measures to be taken to prevent ragging in the institution and steps to be taken to identify the offenders and punish them suitably.

You are also requested to furnish the CD/Photographs of the Workshop /Seminar /Conference to be conducted by your Dental College and also furnish the list of participants of the above Workshop /Seminar /Conference to DCI, by 15th November 2019 positively, for furtherance in the matter.

MEASURES FOR CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS – IMPLEMENTATION OF DIRECTIONS OF HON'BLE SUPREME COURT OF INDIA - information as per section 12.1 of DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009 to be uploaded on DCI website by 30.04.2019 – Regarding.

Sir/Madam.

I am directed to say that as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, it is the responsibility of all the institution to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in their dental institution and measures taken to curb it may be reviewed.

- As per section 11.3 of the aforesaid regulations, the authorities/Management (Trust, Societies, etc.)
 of the institution, particularly the Head of the institution, shall be responsible to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in the institution. In case any incident of ragging takes place, the Management/Head shall take prompt and appropriate action against the person(s) whose dereliction of duty lead to the incident. The authority designated to appoint the Head shall, in its turn, take prompt and appropriate action against the head.
- All dental institutions should issue advertisements against ragging through signboards, pamphlets etc. before the commencement of academic year as well as during the midst of the session. You are also requested to issue booklets to all the students of your Institutions containing the details about what constitutes ragging, punishable ingredients of ragging, punishments and penalty for ragging, names and mobile numbers of the members of the Anti Ragging Squad, Anti Ragging Committee (Anti Ragging Helpline), Wardens, Deputy Wardens of Men's and Women's hostel.
- All dental Institutions shall designate any of their faculty member(s) as "Counsellor" for fresher and senior students to co-ordinate the batches of students (Counselees) regularly about day-to-day problems and also to sensitize their role in curbing the menace of ragging.
- 5. You are further requested to obtain and file undertaking, on anti ragging, from all parents/guardians and students (1st year to final year) studying in BDS/MDS/PG Diploma/Para Dental Courses or any other course approved/recognised by DCI, online through www.antiragging.in / www.amanmovement.org.
- 6. Besides above, it is also pertinent to mentioned here that, as per section 12.1 of subject regulations, each and every institution shall submit its reports in prescribed format (Annexure-II) to the Secretary, Dental Council of India, Aiwan-E-Galib Marg, Kotla Road, New Delhi-110002, by 30th April of every year in respect of the previous academic session, indicating the requisite information against each column thereof, failing which the Dental Council of India, as per section 11.4 of Regulations of Challenge 2000, shall impress graves are new combination of the Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall impose any one or any combination of the following penalties on it:-
 - To initiate the derecognition process against the institution under section 16A of the Dentists Act, 1948.
 - To reduce the ad'mission capacity of the institution to the extent to which the Council deem fit.
 - To stop further admission in the institution till further orders.
 - 11.4.4
 - To stop renewal of permission in respect of UG/PG Dental Courses.

 To post the information regarding penalties so imposed on the concerned institution on the website of DCI for information of all concerned. 11.4.6

- 7. Further, it is also to inform you that the DCI has developed an online module to upload the requisite information / documents on DCI website to reduce the paper work and to scrutiny the above data efficiently, accordingly, it has been decided that the all the requisite information / documents required as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall be uploaded on DCI website and any hard copy of Information / documents received by Post or sent by E-mail shall NOT be considered by DCI.
- 8. In view of the above, I am directed to request you that the requisite information in the prescribed format (Annexure-II as prescribed in DCI Regulations) for the <u>previous academic session 2018-2019</u> may kindly be uploaded on DCI website <u>by 30.04.2019</u>, positively, as the said information is required to be sent to the Monitoring Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. In case the information is not uploaded <u>by 30.04.2019</u> on DCI website, the name of defaulting institution will be forwarded to the said Monitoring Committee for such appropriate action as may be deemed fit and proper by the said Hon'ble Monitoring Committee, and their names will also be uploaded on DCI Website.

विषय: आरत के माननीय सर्वोच्य न्यायालय के दिशानिर्देशों के कार्यान्वयन एवम दंत कॉलेजों में रैगिंग की बुराई पर रोक लगाने वाले डीसीआई विनियम, 2009 की धारा 12.1 के अनुसार शैक्षिक संस्थानों में रैगिंग की बुराई पर रोक लगाने के लिए सूचनाएं 30.04.2019 तक डीसीआई की वेबसाइट पर अपलोड करने हेतु।

महोदय,

मुझे यह कहने का निर्देश दिया गया है कि डीसीआई के नियमों के मुताबिक, दंत चिकित्सा महाविद्यालयों में रैगिंग की बुगई पर रोक लगाने के लिए डीसीआई विनियम के अनुसार सभी दन्त संस्थानों की यह जिम्मेदारी है कि वे यह सुनिश्चित करे कि उनके दंत संस्थान में रैगिंग की कोई घटना न हो और इसे रोकने के लिए किए गए उपाय की समीक्षा की जाए।

- 2. उपर्युक्त नियमों की धारा 11.3 के अनुसार, संस्थान के प्राधिकारी / प्रबंधक वर्ग (ट्रस्ट, सोसाइटी आदि), विशेष रूप से संस्थान का अध्यक्ष यह सुनिश्चित करने के लिए जिम्मेदार होगा कि संस्थान में रैगिंग की कोई घटना न हो। यदि रैगिंग की कोई घटना घटती है तो वह प्रबंधक वर्ग / अध्यक्ष ऐसे व्यक्ति / व्यक्तियों के विरुद्ध तत्काल और उपयुक्त कार्रवाई करेगा जिनके कर्तव्य की लापरवाही से यह घटना हुई। तदनंतर अध्यक्ष को नियुक्त करने वाला पदनामित अधिकारी अध्यक्ष के विरुद्ध तत्काल और उपयुक्त कार्रवाई करेगा।
- 3. सभी दंत संस्थानों को अकादिमिक वर्ष के आरंभ होने के साथ-साथ सब के दौरान भी साइनबोर्ड, पुस्तिका आदि के माध्यम से रैगिंग रोकने के लिए विज्ञापन देना चाहिए। आपसे अनुरोध किया जाता है कि अपने संस्थान के सभी छात्रों को पुस्तिकाएं जारी करे, जिसमें विवरण हो कि रैगिंग क्या है, रैगिंग की दंडनीय गतिविधिया, रैगिंग करने पर दंड व जुर्माना और रैगिंग विरोधी दस्ते के सदस्यों (एंटी रैगिंग कमेटी और एंटी रैगिंग हैल्पलाइन), पुरुष व महिला होस्टल वार्डन्स / डिप्टी वार्डन्स आदि के नाम और मोबाइल नंबर।
- 4. सभी दंत संस्थान अपने किसी भी संकाय सदस्य (सदस्यों) को नये और विरिष्ठ छात्रों के लिए "सलाहकार" के रूप में नामित करे, जो दिन-प्रतिदिन की समस्याओं के बारे में नियमित रूप से विद्यार्थियों (काउसेलीस) के दल को समन्वियत करने तथा रैगिंग कि बुराई को रोकने में उनकी भूमिका को संवेदित करने के लिए निर्दिष्ट करते रहें।
- 5. आपसे यह भी अनुरोध किया जाता है कि आप ऑनलाइन के माध्यम (www.antiragging.in / www.amanmovement.org) से बीडीएस / एमडीएस / पीजी डिप्लोमा / पैरा डॅटल पाठ्यक्रम या डीसीआई द्वारा मान्यता प्राप्त किसी भी अन्य पाठ्यक्रम में पढ़ाई करने वाले सभी छात्रों (प्रथम वर्ष से अंतिम वर्ष) और उनके माता-पिता / अभिभावको से रैंगिंग विरोधी होने का वचन पत्र प्राप्त करे।
- 6. उपर्युक्त के अलावा यह भी उल्लेखनीय है कि रैगिंग की बुराई पर रोक लगाने वाले डीसीआई विनियम के खंड 12.1 के अनुसार प्रत्येक दंत संस्थान को पिछले शैक्षणिक सन के संबंध में अपेक्षित जानकारी (संलग्नक-॥ के निर्धारित प्रारुप में) अपनी रिपोर्ट सचिव, भारतीय दंत परिषद, ऐवान-ए-ग़ालिब मार्ग, कोटला रोड, नई दिल्ली 110002 को, प्रत्येक वर्ष 30 अप्रैल, तक प्रस्तुत करें अन्यथा भारतीय दंत परिषद दन्त कालेजों मे रैगिंग की बुराई पर रोक लगाने वाले डीसीआई विनियम, 2009 के खंड 11.4 के अनुसार निम्नलिखित दंड के किसी एक या किसी भी संयोजन को लागू करेगा:

- 11.4.1 दंत्य चिकित्सा अधिनियम, 1948 के खंड 16ए के अधीन संस्थान के विरुद्ध मान्यता समाप्त करने की कार्रवाई शुरू करना।
- 11.4.2 संस्थान की दाखिला क्षमता में उतनी कमी करना जितना परिषद उचित समझे।
- 11.4.3 अगले आदेश होने तक संस्थान में और आगे दाखिले बंद करना।
- 11.4.4 यूजी/पीजी दंत्य पाठ्यक्रमों के संबंध में अनुमति का नवीकरण बंद करना।
- 11.4.5 संबंधित संस्थान पर इस तरह लगाए गए देडों से संबंधित सूचना सभी संबंधितों की जानकारी के लिए डीसीआई के वेबसाइट पर प्रस्तुत करना।
- 7. इसके अलावा, आपको यह भी सूचित करना है कि कागजी काम को कम करने और आवश्यक जानकारी / दस्तावेज अपलोड करने ओर उपर्युक्त डेटा की जांच करने के लिए डीसीआई ने डीसीआई वेबसाइट पर एक ऑनलाइन मॉड्यूल विकित्तत किया है, <u>और यह निर्णय लिया गया है कि दंत कॉलेजों में रैंगिंग की बुगई पर ग्रेक लगाने वाले डीसीआई विनियम. 2009 के अनुसार सभी आवश्यक जानकारी / दस्तावेज डीसीआई विवसाइट पर अपलोड किए जाएंगे और किसी भी सूचना / दस्तावेजों की पोस्ट द्वारा प्राप्त हाई कॉपी या ई-मेल द्वारा भेजी गयी जानकारी डीसीआई द्वारा नहीं मानी जाएगी।</u>
