DEED OF DECLARATION OF PUBLIC CHARITABLE TRUST

This deed of declaration of public charitable trust is executed on this 2nd day of February, 2022 by Ms. Mudita Gupta (AADHAR NO. 299520688391) a Hindu aged about 31 years w/o Sh. Avneesh Kumar R/o B H-68, 2ND FLOOR, SECTOR-70, NOIDA, GAUTAM BUDDHA NAGAR, UTTAR PRADESH-201301 (hereinafter called "*the author of the trust*").

WHEREAS the said Ms Mudita Gupta wishes to create an Alumni Trust among its students, ex-students, etc.. of Inderprastha Dental College, Sahibabad, an educational Institute registered under the society Registration act, 1860 as amended up to date.

WHEREAS the said Ms Mudita Gupta has already set apart a sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) in cash towards constituting a Public Charitable Trust constituting herself and 6 others as trustees, subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

AND WHEREAS trustees have also accepted the trust fund as stated above.

AND WHEREAS it has become necessary to declare the objectives and terms of the Public Charitable Trust.

Now this Deed of Declaration of the Public Charitable Trust witnesses as under.

1. That The Author of the Trust does hereby declare that he has irrevocably settled an amount of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) **as trust property** for the sole purpose that it should form the nucleus and corpus fund of the Trust and that it has been accepted and acknowledged by the trustees, who have consented to act as trustees, to have, own, hold and be in possession of the same in TRUST and which term shall mean and include not only the said sum of Rs 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand Only) **as trust property**, under these present, but also the addition and accretion to the same by way of donation, profits, further gifts, endowments etc ., and all the investments for the time being representing the same for certain specified charitable objects, (**hereinafter stated**) and accordingly the TRUSTEE hereby declare that they shall continue to hold the TRUST funds in TRUST for these objects and purpose in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in these presents subject to conditions hereinafter stated.

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The name of the trust shall be "Alumni Trust of Inderprastha Dental College and Hospital" (i.e. AtiDCH) and its office shall be at present situated at 46/1, Sahibabad Industrial Area Site 4, Sahibabad, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh 201010 and at other place or places as the trustees hereinafter may decide from time to time.

3. NATURE AND BENEFICIARY:

The TRUST shall be a public charitable TRUST whose beneficiaries shall be the People of India in particular and humanity at large without any distinction or regard to religion, race, caste, creed, community, sex, place of birth or any them.

Also, the TRUST declared is irrevocable. The AUTHOR of the trust hereby Expressly further declares that neither he reserves any right to revoke the Trust nor entitled to any benefit either directly or indirectly from the Trust under any circumstances.

4. OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:

The main objects for which the TRUST is established are:

a) To create, acquire, establish, develop, engage, train, fund, aid, run, continue, conduct, encourage, maintain, assist, provide, administer, promote without limitation, all types and modes of research, innovation, invention, intellectual properties, technology, prototyping and technology management, knowledge sourcing etc, in all fields in general and in the fields of medical Science in particular.

b) to provide grant, scholarship, free ships and other forms of financial Assistance to the students, researchers, irrespective of their caste and creed for pursuing education, vocational training, skill development for undertaking research activities or otherwise, and

c) to encourage and facilitate the alumni taking up activities that are geared to improve society at large and contribute to national development by creating social connect with the alumni and various regional alumni associations across the globe.

d) to bring the old students of Inderprastha Dental College and Hospital, under one roof for exchange of experience, dissemination of knowledge and talents amongst its members and also for the advancement of scientific knowledge in general of the community and the country. Also, to sustain interaction or help to increase interaction between the Institute and the Alumni.



e) to enhance, modernize and upgrade the existing facilities at the institute with the assistance/involvement of alumni.

f) to make available the professional sensitization/knowledge/experience and other such facilities to the present students with the help past students in various industries

g) to publish and circulate books, papers, periodicals and circulars either through print or electronic media for the promotion or stimulation of Dental research at the institute.

h) to grant scholarships to deserving students and to arrange to provide loans and other monetary and non-monetary assistance to deserving students of the Institute for higher education.

i) to undertake, conduct, carry on, help to carry on scientific /academic study and research in Dental.

j) To organise or assist to organise lectures, seminars, refresher courses, conferences, get together etc.

k) to encourage educational cultural fund-raising sports and such other activities as Governing body may deem fit in furtherance of the objects.

5. TRUSTEES, BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND THEIR OTHER CONSTITUTION:

a) The first trustees of the trust shall be:

1. Dr. Mudita Gupta
2. Dr. Avneesh Kumar
3. Dr. Kannu Sharma
4. Dr. Rashmeet Nagpal
5. Dr. Anshika Sharma
6. Dr. Priyanka Kumari
7. Dr. Debarghya Bhattacharyya

b) All the Trustees will be collectively known as Board of Trustees.



c) The First Trustees can co-opt other member as trustees subject to a Maximum number of 11 Trustees. The First Trustees can elect two representatives per patch who have already passed out from Inderprastha Dental College, Sahibabad, Who can also become trustee subject to selection through elective process.

d) The TRUSTEES hereby appointed and /or co-opted shall hold office for a Period of 3 (Three) years from the date of this Trust deed and thereafter 1/3 of the Trustees shall be Subject to retirement and shall be eligible to be re-elected in the Annual General Meeting.

d) No Trustee shall hold the office continuously for more than 2 terms. However, he /she shall be eligible to be re-elected after a break of one Term.

e) in case of the casual vacancy that may arise among the trustees due to the reasons of illness, death, insolvency, resignation or otherwise by operation of any law in force, the casual vacancy shall be filled by co- option for the un-expired period through a resolution by Board of trustees.

f) the Trustees shall nominate the following office bearers among themselves:

1. President- ONE
2. Secretary- ONE
3. Treasurer- ONE

6. MEMBERSHIP:

a) ALUMNI MEMBERS:

All individuals who have passed out from Inderprastha dental College, Sahibabad and upon graduation and post graduation including super specialty/ other qualification etc. and who have paid the life membership fee will be automatically deemed to be a life time member of the Alumni Trust.

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b) ASSOCIATE MEMBERS:

Academic staff, non-academic staff who is not alumni of Inderprastha dental College, Sahibabad, shall be entitled to apply for registration of membership in the prescribed Form so long as they continue to hold designated posts in Inderprastha dental College, Sahibabad.

c) HONORARY MEMBERS:

The Board of Trustees can invite Honorary Member who possesses the higher knowledge in all fields and the field of Medical Science. Honorary Member is not required to pay Alumni Trust fee. Honorary members will hold the membership for two years and he will be eligible for re-appointment upon approval of the Board of Trustees.

7. POWERS OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

- a) To manage, run, establish, maintain, conduct and administer the activities of the trust in fulfillment of the object of the TRUST.
- b) to receive any monetary or other assets and properties in any shape or form as and when given by the AUTHOR of the TRUST or any other persons as gift, donation and endowments as per the rules of the trust and to hold the same as part of the capital fund/ corpus/ income of the TRUST.
- c) to collect funds by way of donation, subscription, grants, present contribution and other form of offering so as to augment the TRUST Funds or to make donation or contribution or otherwise apply the TRUST Funds towards objects of the TRUST.
- d) To acquire on lease or by purchase or otherwise and to sell, mortgage, to lease out or transfer in any other manner, properties, movable or immovable, and to construct buildings, manage and to deal with such properties and all other assets of the TRUST and to pledge, hypothecate or otherwise create a lien over them to raise funds, and to deal generally with the assets, in good faith, for the purpose of achieving the objects of the TRUST.

- e) to receive, collect, realize or cause collection, realization of all interest, Dividends, bonus or premium that accrues or become due to all or any of the stock, funds, securities, debentures or deed or documents of like nature
- f) To represent the TRUST in all courts or before any other authorities and department of Governments, semi-Governments, local authority or any other statutory bodies in respect of TRUST matters.
- g) to executive or negotiate all the necessary papers and documents whether negotiable or non-negotiable and to receive moneys or other assets and to grant receipt and discharge in respect thereof.
- h) to sign and verify all pleadings, memorandum of appeal, petition and application of all kind of compromise or refer to arbitration ,the whole or any part of the claim by or against the TRUST to engage lawyers or other professional and to take all such other necessary steps in pursuing any legal proceeding.
- i) To borrow for the purpose of the TRUST on personal credit of the TRUST With or without charge or lien upon the assets of the TRUST.
- j) to meet all the necessary expenses incurred or to be incurred in connection with the creation and execution of the TRUST.
- k) To open and maintain accounts of any nature in any banks/ of their choice and Authorize operation of the said accounts by the member of the BOARD OF TRUSTEES jointly or severally.
- l) the BOARD OF TRUSTEES shall have the power to delegate all or any of the power vested with them by these present to any other TRUSTEE or committee or any other person.
- m) the powers enumerated above shall be exercised by the board of TRUSTEES subject to their satisfying the condition laid down under Section 11,12,13 of the income tax act 1961 (43 of 1961) as amended from time to time so that the income of the TRUST will be exempted from Income tax for each every assessment year.

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n) The powers vested in the BOARD OF TRUSTEES shall be exercised according to the decision of the majority of the members of the BOARD OF TRUSTEES and by way of resolution passed either by circulating or at the meeting of the BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

o) To do all other acts, deeds, matters and things which may be deemed necessary and expedient for carrying out the objects of this TRUST or its administration.

p) To frame rules and regulation with regard to the institution being run by the TRUST in conformity with statutory requirement for such administration and governance

8. ROLE OF THE PRESIDENT:

a) Oversee the daily operation of the Trust.

b) Responsible for delegating tasks to other officers.

c) Responsible to co-sign along with the trustee important document such as major contracts, legal document, stock certificates, and the like.

9. ROLE OF THE SECRETARY

The secretary keeps Trust records and prepares minutes of the board Meetings, recording minutes of a meeting that the secretary takes Note of who is present, the names of member, and other formalities in a document.

10. ROLE OF THE TREASURER:

a) Treasure is essentially in charge of funds with in TRUST. Treasurer is also responsible for banking, book keeping, record keeping, financial planning and budgeting.

b) Responsible to the co-signatory for all banking transaction along with other Trustees.

11. SUBSCRIPTION AND FEES:

Lifetime Membership Fee:

a) students who have completed graduation course/ other qualifications/ specialisation course in Inderprastha dental College, Sahibabad and who have paid Alumni membership fee is not required to pay any additional fee.

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b) students who have not paid Alumni fee for full all the years as mentioned in the clause a.) above, are required to pay for Alumni fee as mentioned in the Bye-law for the balance tenure.

c) students who have completed course and post-graduation course etc. in Inderprastha dental College, Sahibabad and have not paid Alumni fee are required to pay for Alumni fee as mentioned in the Bye-law.

Associate Membership Fee.

a) The Associate membership fees of the Trust shall be mentioned in the Bye-law of the Trust.

b) The membership and subscription fees are subject to revision from time to time with the approval of the General Body.

12. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP:

The Member of alumni Trust may ceases any individual status as a member under any of the following circumstances:

a) Resignation, death, Mental Disability/unsound mind, or Criminal conviction.

b) Expulsion due to misconduct:

The Board of Trustees shall have power to expel a member for willful disregard to the Trust rules or misconduct on the part of the member, provided that the member concerned will be given an opportunity for Explaining his conduct.

c) Resignation:

A resignation from membership shall be tendered to the president and it shall not take effect until it has been accepted on behalf of the Trust by The Board of Trustees.

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MEMBER RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS:**Member Rights:**

- a) All members will have voting right to elect the Trustees as mentioned in bye laws of the trust.
- b) All members will have right to contest for elections held by the Trust.

Member Obligations:

- a) Members are expected to conduct themselves in line rule and regulations of this trust deed while representing Alumni and participating in the alumni Trust activities.

14. CORPUS OF THE TRUST:

The CORPUS of the TRUST shall mean and include the sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) declared as the trust property and all the other funds and investments for the time being representing the same. It shall also include such gifts, donations, endowments as may be received from the AUTHOR of the trust or any other person which are required to be kept as part of the CORPUS of the TRUST and also the Investments for the time being, representing the same. It shall also mean and include any other sum required to be kept as part of the CORPUS of the TRUST.

15. TRUST FUNDS OR TRUST PROPERTY:

TRUST funds or property shall mean and include not the corpus of the trust but also the income arising to the trustee/s which remains unapplied or accumulated for application towards the object of the trust and all the investment for the time being representing the same.

It shall also include all the assets, tangible and intangible benefits and rights acquired during the existence of this fiduciary obligations for the benefits of the trust and also the investments and proceeds representing the same in the possession of the trustees in the course of the administration of the trust and all the investments for the time being representing the same.

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UTILISATION OF FUNDS:

The funds of the Trust shall be solely utilized for the achievement of the objects and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to TRUSTEES, by way of distribution of profits, dividends, interest etc.

17. MEETINGS:

MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

- a) The Secretary may convene the meeting of the Board of Trustees by serving notice of the meeting on the other members of the BOARD OF TRUSTEES in writing and setting out there in the matter to be discussed and the place of the meeting, the day, date, and time of the meeting.
- b) The BOARD OF TRUSTEES shall meet from time to time but not later than 6 [SIX] months from last meeting and as when necessary to transact issues and for considering the betterment of the TRUST and its assets.
- c) The Board of Trustees Meeting must have $1/3^{\text{rd}}$ of its members with minimum of 5 members to make the quorum out of which President and Secretary must be present.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

- a) The Secretary may convene the General Body Meeting by serving notices of the meeting on to the member in writing and setting out there in the matter to be discussed and place of the meeting, the day, and time of meeting.
 - b) General Body Meeting must have at least 6 members to start the meeting.
18. The office of the TRUSTEES shall be honorary and any person holding such office as trustee shall not be entitled to draw any remuneration for carrying out his duties, but shall be entitled to be paid his actual travelling expenses and other incidental charges incurred by him for attending the meeting of the BOARD OF TRUSTEES or attending to the work of the TRUST. If the Trustees render any services, other than in their capacity as Trustees, e.g. in their professional or other capacity, they shall entitled to be compensated for their additional services on a reasonable basis as may be decided by the Board of Trustees.
19. The accounts of the TRUST shall be duly audited annually by a chartered accountant of and auditor's report on the accounts of the TRUST be obtained.

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20. RULES REGULATIONS AND BYE LAWS OF THE TRUST:

a) It shall be lawful for the Trustees from time to time to frame such rules and regulations for the management and administration of the said Trust as they shall think fit and to alter or amend or vary the same from time to time and to make new rules and regulations.

21. AMENDMENT OF TRUST DEED:

a) The BOARD OF TRUSTEES from time to time shall have power to alter, modify or delete any of the terms of the TRUST deed so as to realise the objects of the TRUST effectively. The BOARD OF TRUSTEES shall also have the powers to add any other OBJECTS which fall under the definition of Public Charitable activities as defined in Section 2(15) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time. However, such modifications and amendments to the TRUST deed shall not be so effected so as to disentitle the Trust from denial of exemption of Income Tax under section 11, 12 and 13 of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

22. The funds and income of the TRUST shall be solely utilised for the achievement of the objects and no portion of it shall be utilised for payment to TRUSTEES, members by way of profits, dividends, interest etc.
23. The BOARD OF TRUSTEES shall be indemnified against and expenses and losses incurred or suffered any payments made by them in the administration of the TRUST and such expenses, losses and payment shall be borne by the TRUST and none of the first TRUSTEES or the members of the BOARD OF TRUSTEES as the case may be shall, in any way, be personally liable or responsible for the same.
24. The Trustees shall carry out their duties as economically and carefully as much as possible. However the TRUSTEES shall not be liable for any loss, damage or other detriment caused to the TRUST in respect of their actions as such TRUSTEES and the TRUSTEES shall be kept harmless and indemnified except for such acts as may amount to fraud and defalcation.



DISSOLUTION OF THE TRUST:

a) In the event of dissolution or winding up of the TRUST, the entire TRUST fund shall be realized and first be used for payment of liabilities of the TRUST and its properties and the remaining as on the date of dissolution **under no circumstances** be distributed among the TRUSTEES/MEMBERS of the managing committee, but the same shall be transferred to another charitable TRUST / Society, whose objects are similar to those of this TRUST, satisfying requirements of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as may be decided by the last Trustees, subject further to the condition that, it shall be given to such an Institution as approved by the Commissioner of Income Tax or Director of Exemptions as the case may be.

Note : That no immovable property is registered in this Trust till date. *The above said office is not the property of this trust.*
