



## REPORT-STUDENT FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM 2023-24

  - 2. Does the curriculum design adequately support overall student development? 159 responses




- 54.7% of students agreed that the curriculum adequately supported their overall development.

- 1.3% of students disagreed that the curriculum adequately supported their overall development.






- 28.9% Strongly agreed that there are enough workshops, seminars and programs in the course curriculum.



6. Is the assessment and evaluation process fair and unbiased? 159 responses




- 31.4% Strongly agreed that the assessment and evaluation process is fair and unbiased.

- 3.8% Disagreed that the assessment and evaluation process is fair and unbiased.



  - 8. Does the curriculum include recent advancements in dentistry? 159 responses




- 32.1% Strongly agreed that the curriculum included recent advancements in dentistry.



#### A list of suggestive actions was made

- 1. Was the course syllabus completed on time?
  - Review the course planning and scheduling processes to ensure realistic timelines for syllabus completion.
  - The teaching plan is updated on LMS monthly & monitored by the Head of the Departments.
- 2. Does the curriculum design adequately support overall student development?
  - Consider integrating more student-centered approaches, such as active learning techniques or personalized learning paths, to enhance development outcomes.
- 3. Is the curriculum conducive to employability in the current scenario?
  - Integrate practical experiences such as internships, projects, or case studies that directly enhance employability skills.
  - Offer career counselling and guidance to help students leverage their academic learning into practical career opportunities.
- 4. Are there enough workshops, seminars, and programs in the course curriculum?
  - Evaluate the scheduling and accessibility of workshops, seminars, and programs to ensure they accommodate diverse student schedules and preferences.
  - Conduct a thorough assessment of current workshop, seminar, and program offerings to identify gaps or areas for improvement.

  - Acknowledge and appreciate the positive feedback from the majority of students (89.9% in total)
  - Foster a culture of experimentation and feedback where faculty and students can collaborate to continuously improve teaching practices.

  - Foster a culture of transparency by clearly communicating assessment criteria, grading rubrics, and expectations to students.

  - The digital library in the LMS was expanded.





18.2% of alumnistrongly agreed that career guidance was provided by the institution.


44.2%% of alumniagreed with the statement.

41.6% of alumni strongly agreed with this statement.






- 24.7% Strongly agreed that the institution adequately prepares students with clinical skills for independent dental practice.











- More value-added programs related to the recent advancements in dentistry will be conducted and discussed in the academic committee meeting.




1. Is there a good balance between theory and practical application in the course? 70 responses

2. Does the curriculum foster student participation in the learning process? 70 responses




- 54.3% strongly agreed that the curriculum fosters student participation in the learning process.








45.7% Strongly agreed to the statement the course content adequately prepared students for independent practice in clinics.


