STEPS TAKEN TO ATTAIN SPECIFIC COMPETENCIES

The following steps have been undertaken:

- The institution introduces basic medical and dental sciences through dedicated lectures. This foundation is crucial for understanding the underlying principles of clinical practice and patient care.
- On the very first day of the posting, students are introduced to the basic protocols of the department. This ensures that they are familiar with the operational and clinical standards of the department, which is essential for their safe and effective participation in patient care.
- To assess students' progress, mid-post and end-post viva examinations are conducted. These evaluations provide both formative and summative assessments, allowing instructors to monitor and guide students' improvement throughout the course.
- Students are encouraged to apply their theoretical knowledge in clinical
 postings by interacting with patients. This takes place under the supervision
 of faculty members, ensuring hands-on practice in real-life scenarios which
 helps in bridging the gap between theory and practice.
- Regular discussions on important topics are conducted to enhance students' theoretical understanding. These discussions allow students to clarify concepts, engage in critical thinking, and reinforce their learning.
- Each student is required to present a seminar on selected topics, promoting independent research, critical analysis, and the development of presentation skills. This also allows for deepening their theoretical knowledge.
- Regular mentor-mentee interactions are facilitated, offering personalized guidance, career advice, and emotional support.
- The institution organizes various CDE programs across different specialties. These programs keep students updated with the latest technologies, research advancements, and evidence-based practices in the field of dentistry
 - Field visits and regular camps are organized to give students real-world exposure.
 - The institution adopts the 10-point UGC Grading System, as outlined by the Dental Council of India (DCI), for assessing students' clinical and practical skills.
