



Note: Orthodontic treatment is a long-drawnprocess, and one has to be a keen observer to be able to read the changes taking place in position of teeth in response to the orthodontic appliance. The response to the appliance may vary from patient to patient. To have a cookbook approach would be difficult but following standard procedural protocols would be sensible.
